## DUTIES OBLIGATIONS

In order to provide safety cover during sailing sessions and facilitate racing, all members are required to volunteer for Sailing Club Duties. The quota for each season will be published by the Vice Commodore but is typically 6 duties a year and half this for Juniors and Students. Members will be provided with an individual log-in to the on-line software DutyMan so that they can volunteer for duties on dates that suit them. You must be 18 or over and have a Safety boat qualification to sign up as Duty Officer.

For those aged 18 or over membership is also conditional on the fulfilment of 4 Centre duty sessions or equivalent, for our landlord, Aztec Adventure (Upton Warren Centre). (A session is half a day or an evening) According to skills/experience, these may be helping with teaching, rescue cover, site maintenance or general assistance at the Centre (roster organised by the Centre). Taking certain approved courses can also count towards Centre duties.

### USE OF CLUB AND AZTEC ADVENTURE (CENTRE) OWNED BOATS

Some Club owned and Centre owned boats are available for members' use during Club sessions. Buoyancy aids may also be borrowed. Sailing Club members are expected to treat Club and Centre property with care and return all equipment to its proper place.

Although Club and Centre boats are insured, an insurance claim excess operates. If a Club/Centre-owned boat is involved in an incident either on or off the water during a Sailing Club activity, resulting in damage to boats or property, then the club member(s) sailing the Club/Centre boat may be held to be responsible for any insurance excess (currently up to a maximum of £100).

### DATA PROTECTION

The information you provide in this form will be used solely for dealing with you as a member of Upton Warren Sailing Club.
