REQUIREMENTS

To become a SUP member you must have your own paddleboard and be competent to launch the board and safely return to shore. You should also be able to steer the board to avoid obstacles. Although a safety boat will be in attendance during water activity sessions you must be able to self rescue, should you fall in the water, and you must have basic swimming skills. A buoyancy aid must always be worn on the water.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTIONS

Family Membership: Families of three or over only pay for the two oldest members, one of whom must be an adult. Please submit a separate application form for each member, labelling the top of each form as Family. Mark up the fees for the first two members and put Free for the younger members.

* Competent paddleboarders under 12 yrs old may become members at the Committee's discretion but a Guardian must remain on site with them at all times.

DUTIES OBLIGATIONS

In order to provide safety cover during water activity sessions, all members are required to volunteer for Club Duties. The quota for each season will be published but is typically 3 duties a year for adult paddleboarders and 2 for Students and Juniors who are 14 and over. Members will be provided with an individual log-in to the on-line software DutyMan so that they can volunteer for duties on dates that suit them. You must be 18 or over and have a Safety boat qualification to sign up as Duty Officer.

Paddleboarders are recommended to sign up as the Assistant Duty Officer, who accompanies the Duty Officer in the Safety boat.

USE OF AZTEC ADVENTURE (CENTRE) OWNED EQUIPMENT

Paddleboarders are expected to use their own equipment but may occasionally use Aztec owned paddleboards during Club sessions, provided that these are not required for Aztec's activities. Buoyancy aids may also be borrowed. Club members are expected to treat Aztec's property with care and return all equipment to its proper place.

If an Aztec-owned board is damaged or causes damage to a third party either on or off the water during a Club activity, then the club member using the board may be held responsible for paying for the damage to the board in full and/or the insurance excess operating for third party cover.

WHATSAPP

The Club has a WhatsApp group which is proving very useful for contacting members quickly and informally - for example to establish how many members are attending a session or to inform of a cancellation forced by adverse weather. Members are automatically enrolled into this group but are welcome to leave if they find it inconvenient.
