#### **DUTIES OBLIGATIONS**

In order to provide safety cover during water activity sessions and to facilitate racing, all members are required to volunteer for Club Duties. The quota for each season will be published but is typically 6 duties a year for our Adult sailing members and half this for Students and Juniors who are 14 and over. Members will be provided with an individual log-in to the on-line software DutyMan so that they can volunteer for duties on dates that suit them. You must be 18 or over and have a Safety boat qualification to sign up as Duty Officer. Our less experienced junior sailors are recommended to sign up as the Assistant Duty Officer, who accompanies the Duty Officer in the Safety boat.

## USE OF AZTEC ADVENTURE (CENTRE) OWNED BOATS AND BOARDS

Aztec owned dinghies and paddleboards are available for members' use during Club sessions, provided that these are not required for Aztec's activities. Buoyancy aids may also be borrowed. Club members are expected to treat Aztec's property with care and return all equipment to its proper place.

Although Aztec boats and paddleboards are insured, an insurance claim excess operates. If an Aztec-owned boat or board is involved in an incident either on or off the water during a Club activity resulting in damage to boats, boards or property, then the club member(s) using the Aztec boat or board may be held to be responsible for any insurance excess. If the damage to Aztec property is deemed to be the result of negligence, then the member will be responsible for paying for the full cost of the damage.

### WHATSAPP

The Club has a WhatsApp group which is proving very useful for contacting members quickly and informally - for example to establish how many members are attending a session or to inform of a cancellation forced by adverse weather. Members are automatically enrolled into this group but are welcome to leave if they find it inconvenient.
