

DATA PRIVACY POLICY UPTON WARREN SAILING CLUB

1. About this Policy

- 1.1 This policy explains when and why we collect personal information about our members, how we use it and how we keep it secure and your rights in relation to it.
- 1.2 We may use and store your personal data, as described in this Data Privacy Policy and as described when we collect data from you.
- 1.3 We reserve the right to amend this Data Privacy Policy from time to time without prior notice. You are advised to check our website www.uwsc.co.uk or our Club noticeboard regularly for any amendments (but amendments will not be made retrospectively).
- 1.4 We will always comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) when dealing with your personal data. Further details on the GDPR can be found at the website for the Information Commissioner (www.ico.gov.uk). For the purposes of the GDPR, we will be the “controller” of all personal data we hold about you.

2. Who are we?

- 2.1 We are Upton Warren Sailing Club who sail at Aztec Adventure Upton Warren Centre. We can be contacted through our website www.uwsc.co.uk

3. What information we collect and why.

4. How we protect your personal data

- 4.1 We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personal data from loss, misuse, or unauthorised alteration or destruction.
- 4.2 Please note however that where you are transmitting information to us over the internet this can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure.
- 4.3 We will notify you promptly in the event of any breach of your personal data which might expose you to serious risk.

5. Who else has access to the information you provide us?

- 5.1 We will never sell your personal data. We will not share your personal data with any third parties without your prior consent (which you are free to withhold) except where required to do so by law or as set out in the table above or paragraph 5.2 and 5.3 below.
- 5.2 We may share your personal data with Aztec Adventure for the purposes of its legitimate interests in managing users of its Upton Warren site. This will be done on an individual needs basis.
- 5.3 We share your name, contact details and sailing and powerboat qualifications with WebCollect for the purposes of managing our membership database. We also share your name, telephone number(s) and email address with DutyMan for duty management processing. Both sites allow you as the member or parent/guardian to change this information as necessary. 6. How long do we keep your information?

- 6.1 We will hold your personal data on our systems for as long as you are a member of the Club and for a year after your last unpaid membership fee fell due. We will review your personal data then and every following year. If we decide we need to retain it to comply with future legal obligations such as the defence of legal claims, we will continue to store your personal data in archive form. If in our judgement, this is not the case, your personal data will be removed from the current or archive database.
- 6.2 If on resignation, you ask to be included in our database of Social Members, who continue to be advised of Clubs social events, then we will continue to store your name and email address in the current database. Your details will continue to remain in this database until you ask for them to be deleted.

6.3 Records of your race positions and trophies awarded will be retained in the Club archives both while you are a Member and after you have resigned your membership of the Club.

7. Your rights

7.1 You have rights under the GDPR:

- (a) to access your personal data
- (b) to be provided with information about how your personal data is processed
- (c) to have your personal data corrected
- (d) to have your personal data erased in certain circumstances
- (e) to object to or restrict how your personal data is processed
- (f) to have your personal data transferred to yourself or to another business in certain circumstances.
